This Instrument, made and entered into this 19th day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty,
between Hartwell Worrell and Martha Worrell his wife of the one part, and Ben. E. Pope of
the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that
the said Hartwell Worrell and Martha Worrell his wife that for and in con-
sideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy five dollars to them in hand paid
by the said Ben. E. Pope at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed
and confirmed unto him the said Ben. E. Pope his heirs and assigns forever, one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
and State of Virginia, containing Eighty one and one fourth acres be the same
more or less and adjoining the Land of Wister Pope, the heirs of William G.
Wilson, the said Ben. E. Pope and others together with all the right, title, interest
claim or demand of, in and to the above described tract or parcel of Land
and the premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of
Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Ben. E. Pope his heirs and assigns
forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Ben. E.
Pope his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Hartwell Worrell and
Martha Worrell his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators
doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Ben. E. Pope his heirs
executors, administrators and assigns, that they will by these presents war-
rant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or
parcel of Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the
claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever. In witness
whereof, the said Hartwell Worrell and Martha Worrell, his wife, have
hereunto set their hands and affixed Their seals the day and year above
