Bishop of the same County of the second part, and Mrs. J. Kindred & Benjamin B. Kindred (Executors of Henry Kindred deceased) son J. Pope, John C. Beale, Parker C. Fox, Lewis Worrell, William Munce Senr. John M. Gurley, Joseph C. Gillette, William S. Schuch, George C. Pope & Co. Elizabeth Fox and William S. Goodwyn and John Baskam all of the same County of the third part: Whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is indebted to the said Mrs. J. Kindred & Benjamin B. Kindred (executors as aforesaid of Henry Kindred deceased) in the sum of five hundred and ninety two dollars and Seventy Three cents, with lawful interest thereon from the Twenty sixth day of February 1848, A.D., as by the bond of the said Seth St. Bishop made payable to the said Henry Kindred having date the 25th day of February 1848 A.D. which said bond is also signed by Mary A. White & St. J. Smith as securities; and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said Benjamin B. Pope in the sum of Three hundred & eighty dollars with lawful interest thereon from the eighth day of May 1849, A.D. by the bond of the said Seth St. Bishop to the said Benjamin B. Pope which bond bears date February 25th 1849 A.D. and is also signed by Mrs. L. Bishop & St. J. Smith as securities and is also subject to a credit for the sum of one hundred dollars paid from 20th 1850 A.D. and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said John C. Beale in the sum of ninety four dollars and fourteen cents due January 5th 1849 A.D. by note or bond; and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said Parker C. Fox in the sum of Twenty five dollars and eighty three cents due September 19th 1850, by note or bond; and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said Lewis Worrell in the sum of twenty five dollars due December 25th 1850, A.D. by note or bond; and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said William Munce, Senior, in the sum of one hundred and three dollars and fifty cents due September 16th 1850 by note or bond; and whereas the said Seth St. Bishop is also indebted to the said John M.
