This Indenture made and entered into this 5th day of November 1850 between E. L. Lumsford and Lucy Ann his wife of the Town of Petersburg of the one part and Robert Ridley of the other part, of the County of Southampton, Virginia, that the said E. L. Lumsford and his wife in consideration of the sum of two hundred & sixty two dollars & sixty cents of lawful money of Virginia, to them in hand paid by the said Robert Ridley, at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Robert Ridley his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton known as apart of the Willow house tract, formerly the property of Robert Nicholson deceased, bounded by the lands of J. Joseph St. Catharine and the said Robert Ridley containing by recent survey two hundred & twenty seven & 2/3 acres more or less, together with all buildings, stables, barns, orchards, lands, tenements, meadows, pastures, feedings, commons, woods, underwoods, ways, waters, water courses, fishings, privileges, profits, easements, commodities, advantages, immunities, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Robert Ridley, his heirs and assigns forever: To Have and To Hold the said tract or parcel of land with the Tenements, hereditaments and all and singular the premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof, unto the said Robert Ridley his heirs and assigns forever. And the said E. L. Lumsford and Lucy Ann his wife, for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land, with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Robert Ridley his heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claims of them or either of them the said Lumsford & Lucy A. his wife or either of them or either their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall, will, and do warrant and defend against the same by these presents.
