receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have bargained and sold, and
by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the
said Robert Ridley his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land

Yellow house tract, formerly the property of Robert Nicholson deceased,
bounded by the lands of Joseph W. Barkham and the said Robert Ridley

meadows, pastures, feedings, commons, roots, underworts, ways, waters,
water courses, fishings, privileges, profits, emoluments, commodities, advantages,
