This Indenture made this 16th day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty between Jesse Johnson and Nancy his wife of the one part and Alfred T. Stephenson of the other part, and all of the County of Southampton, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Seven dollars to them the said Jesse Johnson and Nancy his wife in hand paid by the said Alfred T. Stephenson at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, they the said Jesse Johnson & Nancy his wife, have bargained and sold, released and confirmed and by these presents do bargain and sell, release and confirm unto him the said Alfred T. Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest which they the said Jesse Johnson and Nancy his wife do now or may hold to that certain tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances, situate, lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows, To wit by the laws of Alfred T. Stephenson & Jesse Johnson, commencing at a pine in Jesse Johnson's line, and thence along a line of marked trees to the road leading from Jerusalem to Blackwater Bridge, and up said road to a post and thence a line of marked trees to the spring, continuing by recent survey Ten acres, Two rods, and thirteen poles (D. E. 185) be the same more or less. To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises hereinafter mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Alfred T. Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever.
