And the said Robert St. Prelox on his part covenants and agrees that he will release the said Edwin Williford from the obligations of this indenture upon the said Edwin Williford paying him the amount aforesaid with interest, as well as all other moneys which may be due and owing to him from the said Edwin Williford by means of any debt whatever.
