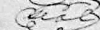

and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and true sum of
two thousand dollars to which payment will and truly to be made to the said
Commonwealth of Virginia, we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators
jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated
this 16th day of December 1850.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bond
James Holmes was on the 16th day of December 1850 by the Board of School
Commissioners in and for the said County of Southampton appointed Superin-
tendant of Schools for said County for the year commencing the first day of
January 1851. Now if the said James Holmes shall faithfully apply
& account for all monies which may come to his hands by virtue of his
Office, and shall, do, perform and execute all and every act and thing ap-
pertaining to his Office according to Law during his continuance therein,
then the above obligation to be void, or else to remain in full force
and virtue.

This Indenture made and entered into on the 5th day of December in the year of our Lord
eighteen hundred and fifty, between Henry Jones and Phoebe Jones his wife of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Edward Crumpler of
the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Jones and
Phoebe his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand one hundred
dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said
Edward Crumpler, at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained
and sold unto him the said Edward Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever
one certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Andrew containing present
embrace three hundred and fifty acres, be the same now or late, it being
the tract of land whereon the said Henry Jones now resides, and
bounded by the lands of Robert S. Casner, John S. Conkern, Lafayette
Crown, John Swallow and others. To have and to hold the above
described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular the
appertinances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, the grace
grants excepted, unto him the said Edward Crumpler his heirs and assigns
forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Edward
Crumpler
