Holland his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing 83 acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton State of Va. and bounded as follows. To wit: on the east by William Collier line on the south by Mat. Tangham's line on the west by Anthony Tangham's line and on the north by George W. Holland's line together with all the timbers and other appertinances whatsoever to the said B. Holland, to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appertinances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights, menses and appertinances unto the said Bryant Holland his heirs and assigns forever to and for the proper use and behoof of him the said B. Holland his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edw. Doughton and wife their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular appertinances before mentioned unto the said B. Holland his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of them the said Edwin Doughton and his wife or their heirs, and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
