This Indenture made this 10th day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty Between William Hatfield of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Spikes Beal of the second part and of the County of Isle of Wight and State of Virginia and Randolph Fowler of the 3^d part and county of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said William Hatfield in order to secure the payment of certain debt due by note and owing to said Beal and the said Spikes Beal security for the sum of one hundred and six dollars and seven cents bearing date with these presents and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Randolph Fowler before the enclosing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth grant bargain and sell and set over to the said R. Fowler his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty two acres and 1/2 more or less lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows and Harrison Ogden to have and to hold with every appurtenance unto the said Randolph Fowler his heirs and assigns whom trust forever, and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents, that if the said William Hatfield shall personally pay unto said Beal his heirs or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and six dollars and seven cents with interest agreeable to the tenor of the same, then the said R. Fowler his heirs or assigns shall hold the said land above granted to the sole and proper use
