same to be her act and deed and declares that she had
willingly signed, sealed and delivered the same not that she wished

This Indenture made this 15th day of October in thousands eight hundred and fifty between
William Hathfield of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia the first
part and Spikes Seal of the second part and of the County of Isle of Wight
and State of Virginia and Randolph Fowler of the 3rd part and county of
Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said William
Hathfield in order to secure the payment of certain debt due to him and
owing to John Bowes and the said Spikes Seal security for the sum of
one hundred and six dollars and seven cents bearing date with these
presents and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand
paid by the said Randolph Fowler before the making and delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth grant
Bargain and sell and set over to the said R. Fowler his heirs and
affigns one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty two acres
and 1/2 more or less being in the County of Southampton and bounded on
Bowes and Harrison Sylver. To have and to hold with every appur-
tenance unto the said Randolph Fowler his heirs and affigns upon
trust forever, and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and
meaning of these presents, that if the said William Hathfield shall
punctually pay unto Carr Bowes his heirs or affigns the aforesaid sum
of one hundred and six dollars and seven cents with interest agree-
able to the tenor of the bond, then the said R. Fowler his heirs or affigns
shall hold the said land above granted to the sole and proper use
