 bargain and sell, alien enfeoff, convey and confirm unto the said Joseph E. Gillett his heirs
 and assigns a certain piece or parcel of land being and lying in the said County of Southampton
 containing one hundred & sixty six acres and bounded as follows, To wit: Beginning at an
 old point dam on the line between Thomas Lane and Joseph E. Gillett, from thence a straight
 line in an east course down Thomas's path to a maple tree in the branch thence down the
 branch to Thomas's line, thence along his line to Misses Foy's line, thence along his line
 to Joseph E. Gillett's line thence along his line to John S. Darden's line thence along his line
 to the Road, thence along the road to Gillett's line thence along his line to the old
 pond again, being part of the tract of land conveyed to the said Richard S. Darden
 by David Carrel and Hannah G. his wife by Deed bearing date the 20th day of June
 1837, and of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court, with all and singular
 rights, privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining.
 To have and to hold the above described piece or parcel of land with its appurtenances
 unto him the said Joseph E. Gillett his heirs and assigns forever. To the only proper
 use and behoof of the said Joseph E. Gillett his heirs and assigns forever. And the
 said Richard S. Darden and Caroline F. his wife for themselves their heirs, executors,
 and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Joseph E.
 Gillett his heirs and assigns that they will forever warrant and defend the title to
 the above conveyed piece or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the
 said Joseph E. Gillett his heirs and assigns against the claims of themselves
 and against the claims of all their persons whomsoever.
