This deed made the 22^d day of November in the year 1850 between Thomas Carroll of Warren Co. North Carolina & Geo. W. Carroll of the County of Isle of Wight & State of Va. Executors of Jas. Carroll dec'd on the one part, and Geo. C. Gwaltney of the Co. of Surry & State of Va. on the other part: Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred & fifty dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Thos. Carroll & Geo. W. Carroll Exors. do grant unto the said Geo. C. Gwaltney all that tract or parcel of land lying in the Co. of Southampton: being the same tract devised to Mrs. Elizabeth Hines dec'd by her late husband George Hines by his will and by her conveyed to the said Geo. Carroll by deed bearing date the 15th of May 1839 and duly recorded in the Clerk's office of Southampton County Court on the 17th day of June, 1839, containing Six hundred & seventy four acres more or less, situated on the south side of the Albemarle Swamp adjoining the lands of Henry Butts, Saml. T. James, Henry James & Thos. (which the said Geo. Carroll died seized & possessed. and the said Thos. Carroll & Geo. W. Carroll Exors. &c. agree with the said Geo. C. Gwaltney that they will warrant specially the Land hereby conveyed. Witness the following signatures & seals

This Deed made the 25th day of December in the year 1850, between John W. Rochelle and Cecile his wife of the one part and Littleton K. Edwards of the other part: Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars the said John W. Rochelle and Cecile his wife do grant unto the said Littleton K. Edwards all their interest being one moiety in value in a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and Suffolk, supposed to contain fifteen hundred acres more or less, being the lands formerly owned Samuel B. Hines, the interest hereby conveyed being the same which the said Rochelle purchased of Saml B. Hines by deed admitted to record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County the 4th day of November
