and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this
20th day of January 1857.

bonds Alexander Myrick the present Sheriff of Southampton County, has by
a Commission from the Governor dated the fourth day of January one
thousand eight hundred and fifty one, with the seal of the Commonwealth
annexed, been continued in the said Office of Sheriff until the next term of
the Court to be held for said County in the year one thousand eight hundred
and fifty one until a successor shall be duly qualified. Now Therefore
if the said Alexander Myrick shall faithfully discharge the duties of said
Office or Trust according to Law, then the above obligation to be void and else
