This Indenture made and entered into this the first day of November in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Thomas R. Myrick of the County of Suffolk and State
 of North Carolina of the one part and John D. Myrick of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia, of the other part, witnesseth that the said Thomas R. Myrick in consideration
 of the provisions contained in certain articles of agreement entered into between
 the said parties, bearing even date with these presents and in consideration of the
 sum of ten dollars to him in hand paid by the said John D. Myrick, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained and sold unto the said John D. Myrick, the receipt
 unto date, grant bargain and sell unto the said John D. Myrick ^{half} the interest of him
 the said Thomas R. Myrick in and to the following tracts of Land viz: The Pine woods tract
 in Southampton County Virginia containing two hundred and twenty acres more or
 less, adjoining the land of Ellick Myrick and others, also the Glen and Bescon tracts
 containing five hundred and fifteen acres more or less adjoining Ellick Barnes and
 others situate in Suffolk County, N. Carolina, and also the Fingers tract in
 Suffolk County, N. Carolina containing one thousand three hundred and fourteen
 acres adjoining the Land of John Waddell, Richard L. Conner and B. T. Spier.
 To have and to hold one half of the said Land together with the privileges and
 appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the
 said John D. Myrick his heirs and assigns.

And the said Thomas R. Myrick covenant and agree to with
 the said John D. Myrick his heirs assigns that before the execution of
 this, I have full power, absolute right and authority to sell and convey
 said Lands well forever defend the right and title of the same from the
 lawful claim of any and all persons whatsoever to him the said John
 D. Myrick his heirs and assigns forever.
