This deed made the 7th day of January in the year 1857, between Solomon Barnes of the one part Letherton R. Edwards of the second part and Geo. W. Newson and Clarke & Pope of the third part, Witnesseth that the said Solomon Barnes, doth grant unto the said Letherton R. Edwards the following property, to wit: One bay mare, household & kitchen furniture, one horse cart & gear, one bridle & saddle four cows & twenty three pigs and their future increase farming utensils, eighteen or twenty barrels of corn, two thousand pounds of fodder one thousand pounds of bacon, one shot gun, one bureau, in the possession of Mrs Maria E. Olson. In trust to secure a debt due Ceptha Dusen Sheriff & committee of the estate of John Throp dec'd to which S. N. W. Newson is security and two bonds due Clarke & Pope one for eighteen dollars & fifty nine cents due the 29th December 1850, and the other for thirty dollars due 27th of December 1850 the account due Richard H. This Deed made and entered into this 22nd day of November 1850, between H. T. Smith & his wife Martha of the County of Louthampton, State of Virginia of the one part and Robert Rawls of the County of Hanover and of the same State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said H. T. Smith & wife Martha for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Robert Rawls at or before the executing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said H. T. Smith & Martha his wife have granted, bargained & sold & by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Robert Rawls his heirs & assigns one certain tract of land lying & being in Louthampton County on the west side of the road leading from South Quay to Farmingtonville and containing 360 acres more or less, bounded as follows, commencing at the rim of the Cy. road running in the said road leading from South Quay to Farmingtonville thence up said Swamp to the corner of Elish. Dusen & Elish. Parker thence along Elish. Parker's line of marked trees & various courses to Letherton Moore's corner a black elm at the road in the run of the Mingo Branch thence down said Mingo Branch to Elish. Parker's corner thence along the said Mingo Branch line of marked trees to the aforesaid road thence down said to the first station of the said H. T. Smith & his wife Martha & all other persons claiming to the
