This indenture, made and entered into on this 20th day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred & fifty one, between Henry Bishop of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William D. Bryant of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth, that the said Henry Bishop for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said William D. Bryant on the 25th day of December next, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold unto him the said Wm. D. Bryant his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying & being the aforesaid County of Southampton, containing Tract acres be the same more or less, and bounded by the Lands of said William D. Bryant & Jm. Hargrave, it commencing at the corner of the said Bryant at above and running nearly an east course to an old Black Oak, then curving & running straight to a white oak, then up a little valley to the said Stanger's line to a Sweet gum, then along the said Stanger's line to the same corner point, he the said Henry Bishop do, bargain and sell unto the said Wm. D. Bryant a certain tract or parcel of Land and premises: To have and to hold with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging as aforesaid mentioned unto him the said William D. Bryant his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Henry Bishop for himself & his heirs, Executors & admors. do hereby covenant and agree to & with the said Wm. D. Bryant his heirs Executors, Heirs & assigns, that he will by these presents warrant & forever defend all the right & title of the aforesaid tract or parcel Land and premises hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
