In pursuance of an order of the County of Southampton bearing date July Court, 1844, to me directed and which is hereto annexed, I did first proceed to give public notice of the time and place and then sell for cash to the highest bidder on the premises on the 25th day of January last a certain tract or parcel of land conveyed by deed of trust to Thomas J. Butlow as trustee by James Crake, to secure the payment of a bond held by Thomas Butlow against said Crake. Of which land John M. Kenley became the purchaser for the sum of two hundred and forty five dollars, of which I did pay to Thomas J. Butlow, executor of Thomas Butlow dec^d the sum of one hundred and ninety six dollars and twelve cents being the amount of debt and interest due on said bond, leaving in my hands the sum of thirty four dollars and sixty three cents after paying all expenses attendant on the sale.
