This Deed made the 22^d day of February A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty one
 between William D. Clarke and Ezra his wife of the County of Southampton of the one
 part and James Fagan of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the
 said William D. Clarke and Ezra his wife in consideration of the sum of six
 hundred dollars do grant unto the said James Fagan two lots of land and buildings
 and improvements thereon situate in the Town of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton
 one of said lots containing one acre and designated in the plan of said Town as lot
 No 5. the other containing three fourths of an acre being part of lot designated
 No 6 in said Town, being said lots now conveyed by said Fagan and were conveyed
 to said Clarke by deed from William D. Shanks recorded the 1st day of May
 1849. To have and to hold the aforesaid lots of land with the buildings and
 improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said
 James Fagan his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of the said Clarke
 and wife or either of them and of all and every other person or persons whom
 soever. In Witness whereof, the said Clarke and wife have hereunto set their
 hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
