Hollans at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, the right whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said George W. Hollans his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing 25 acres be the same more or less, lying in the County of Southampton, State of Va. and bounded as follows To wit: on the South by Edwin Daughtry on the west by Anthony Vaughan's line, and on the North by Thomas Vaughan's line, together with all the buildings, fences and other appurtenances what- soever to the said G. W. Hollans; To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said G.
