and William Cobb in consideration of the sum of Twenty-eight Dollars 12<sup>½</sup> in hand to them  
paid by the said G. W. Holland at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents,  
the right whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and do by these presents  
bargain and sell unto the said George W. Holland his heirs and assigns a certain  
tract or parcel of land containing 25 acres be the same more or less, lying in the  
County of Southampton, State of N.Y. and bounded as follows: to wit: on the South by  
Edwin Daughtry on the west by Anthony Vaughan's line, and on the North by Thomas  
Vaughan's line, together with all the buildings, timber and other appurtenances what-  
ever to the said G. W. Holland; To have and to hold the said tract or parcel  
of land with all the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and  
sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights members and  
appurtenances unto the said G. W. Holland his heirs and assigns forever, to and  
for the only proper use and beh. of him the said G. W. Holland his heirs and  
assigns forever. And the said Edwin A. Edwards and William Cobb their heirs, the  
said tract or parcel of land with all its singular appurtenances before mentioned  
unto the said Holland his heirs and assigns forever, free from the claim or claims  
of them. The said E. A. Edwards and W. Cobb or their heirs and of all and every  
person or persons whatsoever shall, will and do warrant and forever defend by
