present, the right whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and do
by these presents bargain and sell unto the said George W. Hollins his heirs and
assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing 41 acres, or the same more or less
lying in the County of Southampton State of Va and bounded as follows: on the
North by James W. Munroe's line, on the west by Joseph Gardin's line, and with
east by Thomas Vaughn's line, together with all the timber and other appurtenances
whatsoever to the said G. W. Hollins. To have and to hold the said tract of land
and with all the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained
