Holland at & before the executing and delivery of these presents, the right whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold one do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said George W. Holland his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing 41 acres, be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton State of Va and bounded as follows to wit, on the North by James W. Munlee's line, on the west by Joseph Gadsden's line, and on the east by Thomas Vaughan's line, together with all the Timber and other appurtenances whatsoever to the said G. W. Holland. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights, liberties and appurtenances unto the said G. W. Holland his heirs and assigns forever, to use for the only proper use and behoof of him the said G. W. Holland his heirs and assigns forever, And the said Edwin F. Edwards and William H.
