This Agreement, made and entered into on the 25th day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty one, between Mark T. Pette and James C. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Henry Jones of the same County and State of the other part, doth certify that the said Mark T. Pette and James C. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand six hundred and Twenty five dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Henry Jones at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint James containing by a late survey Five hundred and eighty three Acres be the same more or less, and bounded as follows, To wit: Beginning at a maple standing near Hinder Mill- house, thence along the Mill dam and Mill path to a corner a corner in Division S. Papes line, thence along his line to the run of a small branch, thence up the run of said branch to the said Mill path, thence along said Mill path to the road, a corner in E. M. Arnold's line thence along the road to the bridge across Blounts Swamp, thence down the run of said Swamp to a cypress a corner for James Powell's Heirs, thence along said Powell's line to a corner for James Papes Heirs, thence along said Papes line to a black Oak a corner in G. C. S. Burkham's line, thence along his line to a sweet gum standing in a branch corner in Henry Pindler sen^r line, thence along said Pindler's line down the run of said branch to the run of said Blounts Swamp, thence up the run of said Swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with and together its appurtenances thence belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Mark T. Pette and James C. his wife for themselves, their heirs, Executors, and Admins: do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Henry Jones his heirs, Executors, Admins: and assigns, that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises not wrongfully obtained thereof against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever - In witness whereof the said Mark T. Pette and James C. his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
