Rollings his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty seven dollars and fifty cents to in hand paid by the said William Felix at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, they have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, and sell, availed release convey and confirm unto the said William Felix his heirs and assigns, all that tenement, tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County with the said Rollings purchase of Benjamin Foyel, and bounded as follows to wit: on the south by the Lands of Edward Curtis on the North East by William Omy, West the Lands of John Kitchen, containing by estimation twenty six acres be it the same more or less, the said William Felix. To have and to hold the tenement tract or parcel of Land and premises, with the appurtenances and all the right title and claim and demands whatsoever of them the said Patrick St. Rollings and Mary A. his wife, and the said Patrick St. Rollings and Mary A. his wife do hereby promise and agree for themselves their heirs, Exors and Admins to have with the said William Felix his heirs and assigns to warrant secure and forever defend the said tenement, tract or parcel of land, and promise against the lawful and demand of all and every person and persons whatsoever.
