This deed made this 29th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one between Seth H. Bishop of the one part and John L. Bishop of the other part: with the effect that the said Seth H. Bishop doth grant unto the said John L. Bishop the following property, to wit: all of the crops of all kinds belonging to the said Seth H. Bishop, to wit: his entire crop of corn, fodder, cotton, potatoes, peas &c. but lately planted or growing on the plantation on which the said Seth now resides, all of his crops of all kinds just planted or growing on the Story plantation, &c. entire crop of corn, fodder cotton potatoes, peas &c. In trust to secure the payment of the following debts to wit: one due to the executors of S. Kindred deceased, for \$592.73 and one bond due to Harrison D. Pope for \$380.00. Subject to a credit of one hundred dollars, to be paid first, & then the following debts to be paid pro rata, viz: a debt to John C. Parker for \$94.14, to Parker & Story \$55.83 to Lewis Woodell \$20.00 to Wm. Munter Sen. \$103.50, to John W. Easley about \$5.00, to Sarah C. Gillette about \$137.00 to Wm. Edelschall about \$28.00 to Geo. C. Pope & Co. about \$26.00, to Elizabeth Story about \$35.00 to Wm. S.
