To have and to hold the same unto the sd. William Cobb to him and to his heirs forever. And the sd. Allen Edwards for himself, his heirs, executors, admrs. and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the sd. William Cobb his heirs and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and defend the right, title, claim or demand of any person claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof.
