Turner of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that we the said Priscilla Jenkins, George Jenkins, and Elizabeth Jenkins for and in consideration of the sum of thirty seven dollars and sixty five cents to us in hand paid by the said William T. Turner, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold, and confirmed unto the said William T. Turner, one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and bounded as follows, To wit: By the lands of James Turner, Richard Harris and William T. Turner, containing thirty and one eighth acres be the same more or less: To have and to hold said lands and tenements with all improvements whatsoever, we do further bind ourselves, our heirs, our executors, Administrators and assigns forever to warrant and lawfully defend the right and title of said land unto him the said William T. Turner against all lawful claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and date above written -
