This indenture made and entered into this fifth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty between John J. Lindes of the first part, William Ward and James Cairnes of the second part and Joseph T. Liles, Arthur Middleton and George B. Middleton of the third part: - Whereas the said William Ward and James Cairnes on the second day of January in the year 1850, in order to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand dollars with lawful interest thereon from the fourth day of December A.D. 1849 did by indenture dated January 2nd. A.D. 1850, convey to the said John J. Lindes and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the county of Southampton, State of Virginia, being a portion of that tract of land which was conveyed to Robin Middleton by Thomas Ridley & wife and William B. Corroym & wife and others, by deed bearing date the 28th. February A.D. 1831, which said tract of land conveyed in the above mentioned deed contains thirteen hundred and seventy three acres, from which is now excepted a tract of two hundred and a half acres, which have been heretofore sold by the said Joseph T. Liles, & wife Arthur Middleton.
