One thousand eight hundred and fifty one, Between Harrison P. Pope of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part and Caswell Woull of the same
County, and State of the other part; Witnesseth that the said Harrison P.
Pope for and in consideration of the sum of twelve dollars to him in hand paid by
the said Caswell Woull at or before the executing and delivery of these
present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained
sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm
unto him the said Caswell Woull his heirs and assigns forever, one certain
tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of
Southampton, containing eleven acres be the same more or less adjoining the
land of Jas. S. Purick, litch Edwards and others and known as a part
of Joel Newton's plantation the same being Simon C. Newton's interest in
said plantation, which was sold under a Cate. and Bot. by the said
Harrison P. Pope together with all the right, title, interest claim or
demand of, in and to the above described tract or parcel of
land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining: To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel
of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belong-
ing unto him the said Caswell Woull his heirs and assigns forever,
to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Caswell
Woull his heirs and assigns forever. and the said Harrison P. Pope
for himself his heirs, Executors and administrators doth hereby cove-
nant and agree to and with the said Caswell Woull his heirs
Executors, administrators and assigns that he will by these presents
warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid
tract or parcel of land and premises, and every part and
parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person
