Bland his executors, administrators and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres - It being a part of the land which I purchased of Simon T. Westbrook whereas the houses stand - and bounded as follows by the lines of the said Joseph M. Bland William H. Jones, William B. Westbrook and said Elizabeth Bland. To have and to hold the said hundred acres of land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph M. Bland his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever - And the said Elizabeth Bland for herself, her heirs, executors, and administrators the said hundred acres of land unto the said Joseph M. Bland, his heirs executors administrators and assigns against the claim of her the said Elizabeth Bland her executors and administrators and against the claim or claim of all and every other person or persons who ever, shall and well warrant and forever defend them by these presents.
