Gray, the sum of forty Dollars due by bonds the 20th day of December one thousand eight hundred & fifty one, the said Micajah Holliman is willing and desirous to secure, and also for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Henry F. Bittle at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Micajah Holliman, hath given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm to the said Henry F. Bittle his heirs and assigns forever, all of his present crop of corn & fodder, his crop of cotton & Brandy, four head of Cattle, seventeen head of Hogs, one sorrel mare, one walnut Table, six sitting chairs, two feather beds & furniture, one desk & three chests, one pair of cast wheels, two plows & gear, one Loom & gear, one spinning wheel & cards, one set of knives & forks one set of cups & saucers, three pots, two dishes, & one set of plates, weeding hoes & two grub hoes, two cutting axes, four saw-hoes & coal-tires, one shot gun, with all the right, title, interest, of the said Micajah Holliman in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted, property aforesaid named. To have, and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted, the property aforesaid named, unto the said Henry F. Bittle, his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof
