Pope his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Harrison S. Pope his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Alex Myrick Sheriff and Commissioner for himself, his heirs, Executors, and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Harrison S. Pope his heirs, Executors, administrators, and assigns, that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of himself only.
