This Deed, made and entered into on the 25th day of September year 1831
by and between Jacob Barnes of the one part and John Harrald of the
other part. Each party of the County of Southampton. This deed witnesses
that the said Jacob Barnes has for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and seventy five Dollars to him the said Barnes in hand paid at
the delivery of this deed by him the said Harrald, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, he the said Jacob Barnes has and he
hereby bargain and sell unto him the said John Harrald, three small portions of land
and sell unto him the said John Harrald, three small portions of land
lying adjoining each other, to-wit: one portion thereof he said Barnes is
the first purchase of Dolly Jackson supposed to contain about
seven acres, another portion thereof James Williams, purchased of
said Jackson supposed to contain Ten acres, the other portion of said
said said Barnes purchase of Emory Beal supposed to contain about
thirty acres, all three portions of land lying in the said county of Southampton
and bounded by the lands of Josiah Fish, Sarah Edlinworth, and the land
