James has in and to a certain lot or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid county & parish, said title now being in reversion it being the land which Benjamin Revel now lives on and in which he has or has had a life estate in, through and by the last will of Halsey Revel dec^d she the said Dorothy C. James being one of the lawful heirs of him the said Benjamin Revel: To have and to hold the before described, interest in the said land and every part and parcel thereof to him the said Jacob Barnes and to his heirs and assigns forever. To have and to hold the same free from the claim or demand of he the said Dorothy C.
