Sope of the said County, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ben. C. Sope, his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the aforesaid County of Southampton, bounded and described as follows, to wit: beginning at the road leading from Chas. W. Parker's to Bethlehem Croft roads in a grove just above the said Chas. W. Parker's residence, running up said road nearly west to Thomas Redleg's line, then bounded on the west and north by the lands of the said Thomas Redleg, and the Indians on the east and south by Harrison P. Sope and Henry B. Vaughan up to said point at the road and beginning: Containing by estimation one thousand four hundred and forty nine and one half acres be the same more or less, together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining and belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Ben. C. Sope his heirs and assigns forever, and I, the said Henry B. Vaughan for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Ben. C. Sope his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the before granted premises, that are free from all incumbrances, that I have a good and perfect right to sell and convey the same to the said Ben. C. Sope his heirs and assigns as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Ben. C.
