 To have and to hold to him the said James Harris his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Jas. McDemore for himself his heirs, executors and administrators due covenant with the said James Harris his heirs and assigns that the said Jas. McDemore will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Jas. Harris his heirs and assigns forever against lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said James McDemore to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said chattel estate and to take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars in whole or in part, and then upon the further trust that the said Jas. Harris shall and will as soon after the happening of such default of payment as he shall be required by the said Howell Harris his executors, administrators or assigns so to all the said chattel estate or such part thereof as shall be sufficient for the purpose at public auction to the highest bidder for ready money after having fixed the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given at least twenty days notice thereof, and out of the proceeds of sale shall after paying the expenses thereof and all other expenses attending the execution of this trust pay to the said Howell Harris his executors, administrators or assigns the debt aforesaid and the interest thereon or such part thereof as may be due, and the balance if any shall pay to the said James McDemore his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns. But if the whole of the said debt and accruing interest shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said Howell Harris his executors, administrators or assigns on or before the 25th day of December next, so that no default of payment of the said debt is made then this mortgage shall be void or else remain in full force.
