This deed made the 15th day of November in January 1857, between Robert Whitehead of the one part and Lillian A. Edwards, of the other part, witnesses that the said Robert Whitehead hath grant unto the said Lillian A. Edwards the following property, to wit: a tract of low-lying and being in Pottery Bay in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation One hundred forty seven and more or less, bounded by the lands of Martha Williams & Eliza Asha Henry and least, James Taylor, (Jr.) Ocean Street (Jr. and the aforementioned Swamp, &c. that to become the payment of a debt due from the said Robert Whitehead to Richard Jackson of three hundred and seventy five dollars to become due and every interest from the 20th day of January 1859. To be paid as follows: fifty dollars of the principal and the interest then due to be paid on the 20th day of January 1859, and fifty dollars and the interest due to be paid annually thereafter of the whole debt is paid. The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above born William M. Briggs was on the 17th day of November 1851, by the board of School Commissioners in and for the County of Southampton appointed Superintendent of Schools for said County for the year commencing the 1st day of January 1852. Now if the said William M. Briggs shall faithfully apply and account for all moneys which may come to his hands by virtue of his office and shall do, perform and execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his office according to Law. During his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
