Miffee his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said George W. Lawrence & Elisha Darden or either of them, their or either of their heirs and of all other persons or persons claiming by them either of them shall, will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. This indenture, made the first day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty, between Elisha Darden as guardian of George W. Lawrence and the said George W. Lawrence in his own right, of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and Mariah Vaughn, widow and executrix of Thomas Vaughn deceased of the County and State aforesaid of the other part: Whereas, that the said Elisha Darden and George W. Lawrence for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars to them in hand for the sole benefit of the said George W. Lawrence by the said Mariah Vaughn paid at and before the cascading and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Elisha Darden as guardian aforesaid and George W. Lawrence, have granted, bargained and sold unto the said Mariah Vaughn aforesaid a certain lot, tract, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and in the aforesaid County, adjoining the lands of the late Thomas Vaughn, James W. Miffee & others; containing Sixty acres more or less; it being one of the pieces or tracts of land devised by the said George W. Lawrence in the division of the lands whereof Wm. E. Lawrence his father died seized and possessed as may be seen by reference to the Commissioner's report of record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County, with all and singular the ruminations and divisions, remainders and remainders, yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Mariah Vaughn as executrix aforesaid, her heirs, executors and administrators. And the said Elisha Darden & George W. Lawrence for themselves, and their heirs the said tract, piece or parcel of land and singular the premises and appurtenances above mentioned.
