This Indenture, made and entered into this eighteenth day of September one thousand
 eight hundred & fifty one, between Polly Branch of Southampton County of the one part
 and Julian J. Branch of Surry County of the other part, & both of the State of
 Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Polly Branch for and in consideration of the
 sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Julian J.
 Branch at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged both grantor, bargained and sold by these presents do grant
 bargain and sell, alien, enjoin and confirm to the said Julian J. Branch his heirs &
 assigns forever, all my right, title, claim and interest in a certain tract or parcel
 of land, containing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less (This
 land formerly belonged to Jno. Williamson dec'd and is the land I hired from
 him the J. Williamson as my portion,) lying and being in the County of South-
 ampton and bounded as follows, to wit: by the land belong to Chas. C. Crant,
 formerly Jno. S. Gwaltney on the east, by the land belonging to the Oct. of Jas.
 B. Wighamot (known as Williamson's) on the north, by the land belonging to Mary
 W. Brittle on the west and that belonging to Cyrus W. Shields on the South & S. West,
 together with all trees, woods, underwoods, with commodities, advantages, hereditaments
 & appurtenances to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also the services
 & reversion, remainder and remainders, rights and services to the said land belonging, and
 every part thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand what-
 soever of her the said Polly Branch, her heirs and assigns of, in, out to the said premises
 or any part thereof, I do have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned
