Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Polly Branch for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Julian J.
Branch at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold by these presents do grant
bargain and sell, alian, enfeoff and confirm to the said Julian J. Branch his heirs &
assigns forever, all my right, title, claim and interest in a certain tract of land
soad, containing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less. This
land formerly belonging to Jno: Williamson &c and is the land I received from
him the Esq: Williamson as my portion, lying and being in the County of South-
ampton and bounded as follows, to wit: by the land belong to Sam'l C. Hart,
formerly Jno: S. Goochay on the east, by the land belonging to the Est: of Jas:
B. Wigham (known as Williamson's) on the north, by the land belonging to Mary
H. Brittle on the west, and that belonging to Exum W. Shields on the South & S. West,
