Dolle the following property, one tract of land containing 37 1/2 acres more or less, bounded by the lands of William Corbitt, Joseph Johnson, Samuel Corbitt, Lawrence Smith and Robert Relford and William Atkinson, together with the following, chattel estate, one horse cart and wheels, 3 beds and furniture 19 head of hogs 4 head of cattle 25 barrels of corn 2000 lbs of fodder, all the household and kitchen furniture together with the increase of the same. On trust to secure on bond of eighty five dollars due Oliver W. Duck with interest from date. Witness our hands and seals, the day and date above written.

William H. Griffen

This deed made this 18th day of November 1857, between James D. Bryant President of the Board of Overseers of the poor of Southampton County, and on behalf of the said Board of Overseers of the one part, and Wm H. Griffen of the other part. Witnesseth that in consideration of One hundred and forty two dollars eighty five cents, the said James D. Bryant as President of the Board of Overseers of the poor and on behalf of the said Board of Overseers with the assent of the Court of the County, affords signature by its own officers of record on the 17th day of June 1850, doth grant unto the said William H. Griffen a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of said said containing forty acres more or less and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a gum stump in the Cat Tail Swamp former corner of Wm H. Griffen and the poor house land thence along a line of marked trees to a sweet gum on the side of the Jerusalem road thence along the road to a post oak a corner of William H. Griffen and the said poor house land thence along a line of marked trees to a pine, a variation on the line, thence along a line of marked trees to a cypress standing in a small branch a corner in William Atkinson's line thence along Atkinson's line of marked trees to a dogwood a new corner made in William Atkinson's line and being also a new corner in the dividing line between William H. Griffen and the said poor house land, thence along that new line south 10 1/2 degrees East 180 poles to the Cat Tail Swamp aforesaid at a Black gum new corner, thence down the Cat Tail Swamp to the first Station. To have and to hold the premises aforesaid unto the said William H. Griffen and his heirs and assigns against the claim of him the said James D. Bryant and all persons claiming by, title or under him and none other. Witness the following signatures and seal.
