This deed made this 22^d day of November in the year 1857, between Edwards Butts of the one part and Lucy Allman of the other part, Witnesseth that the Edwards Butts in consideration of the sum of three hundred ^{fifty} dollars to him in hand paid, doth grant unto the said Lucy Allman a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows: Beginning at a dead oak a corner in the lands of the said Geo. Griffin, thence south by a line of Reddick's old place, thence south by a line of new marked trees to the line dividing Butts old place and the lands of William A. Bell & others, thence west of South to Joseph S. Cusker's line formerly Thomas P. Simmons, thence along said line west to the lands formerly John Ticks, thence along said line to the road leading to Verbeville, thence down the said road to a dogwood near the corner of the fence where Charles Bell has a cotton gin, thence a South East course along said fence and along of marked trees to a dogwood, thence east or nearly so along said line of marked trees to the beginning and containing One hundred and twenty five acres more or less. This deed, made this 22^d day of November in the year 1857, between Edwards Butts of the one part and George Griffin of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Edwards Butts in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid, doth grant unto the said George Griffin a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows: Beginning at a dead oak a corner in the lands of the heirs of Alexander Briggs and Butts old place, thence north or nearly so along the line of the heirs of Alex. Briggs & Butts (formerly) to a branch, which empties into the Village Swamp, thence up the branch to the road near Sedge Blythe's house, thence down said road to a red oak standing near the door of Sedge Blythe's house, thence east or nearly so along said line of marked trees to the beginning and containing One hundred and twenty five acres more or less. And the said Edwards Butts hereby agrees to warrant and defend the title to the aforesaid tract of land unto the said George Griffin against himself the said Butts and all and every other person or persons whatsoever.

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
