Bailey and Mary Bailey of the State of Virginia and County of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of \$36.00 dollars paid us by Allen Raiford of the State and County aforesaid, the receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge as hereby give, grant, sell and convey to the said Allen Raiford his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the aforesaid State and County, containing, more or less, lying on Sea Coast Swamp and bounded as follows viz Commencing at a black gum tree on the south side of aforesaid Swamp, thence a South west up to the mouth of a branch running into the aforesaid Swamp, thence up the said branch to a pine a corner tree in land of the said Henry D. Bailey, thence a northwest corner to a cedar oak a corner tree in the line of Thomas S. Russell, thence down the said Thomas S. Russell line to northwest corner to Ben Baileys branch, thence down the run of the said branch to the run of Sea coast Swamp, thence to the said Thomas S. Russell land, thence the run of the said Swamp to the first named tree. To have and hold the same unto Allen Raiford his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And we covenant with the said Allen Raiford his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the premises, that they are free of all incumbrances and that we well warrant and defend the same to the said Allen Raiford his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
