

This line represents part of the land of George B. Cary and purchased by Joseph H. Barkham bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning in the road inside Barkham's line, thence N. 74³/₄° W. 139 poles to a branch, thence down the branch N. 17° W. 22 poles to a pine & Black gum thence down the run 57 poles to a small Black gum corner of the Nicholson land, thence N. 63¹/₂° W. 8 poles to a small red oak, thence N. 65° W. 133 poles to a small black gum, standing on Browns meadow thence S. 43¹/₂° W. 17¹/₂ poles to a corner in the meadow, thence N. 61° W. 16 poles to a white, thence N. 66° W. 133 poles to a white & red oak, thence N. 63° W. 20¹/₂ poles to a Dogwood, thence N. 65¹/₂° W. 13 poles to a pine & Dogwood marked as a corner for Robert Ridley, thence N. 70° W. 12 poles to a pine, thence N. 58³/₄° W. 25 poles to a pine, thence N. 55¹/₂° W. 20 poles to a pine, thence N. 65° W. 6¹/₂ poles to a pine, thence N. 67° W. 13 poles to a pine, thence N. 73° W. 13¹/₂ poles to a pine, thence N. 76° W. 9¹/₂ poles to a pine, thence N. 82° W. 14 poles to a red oak, thence S. 88¹/₂° W. 11 poles to a pine, thence N. 87° W. 24 poles to a white oak, thence N. 83¹/₂° W. poles to a sweet gum standing on a branch a corner in Robert Ridley's line, thence down the run of said branch to the run of the three creeks, thence down the margin of the run of the creek to an Elm, a new corner for Joshua Dettlow, thence along a new line of marked trees S. 65° E. 496 poles to the road a new corner for said Dettlow in said G. H. Barkham's line, thence along the road South 65 poles, thence S. 28° W. 26 poles to the Beginning - containing three hundred acres.

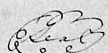

This deed made the 19th day of September One thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Benjamin F. Smith of the one part and Edward W. Maysenburg of the other part, all of the County of St. Ampton & State of Virginia Witnesses that the said B. F. Smith doth grant unto the said Edw. Maysenburg all of his right, title and interest both individually and as the administrator of Lewis W. Bishop dec'd. to all suits now pending in the Circuit Court of St. Ampton County between the said B. F. Smith as owner of Lewis W. Bishop dec'd. Plaintiff and said St. Bishop Defendant, also in a suit in which the said B. F. Smith is Plaintiff against Anthony M. Howell Defendant. In trust to secure two debts due to William Munroe Sr. Conditioned as follows, viz: first receive and then pay off and satisfy the debt of two hundred and eighty nine dollars and thirty six cents due by bond executed and made payable to the said W^m Munroe on or about the 2^d day of May 1851, and then pay off and satisfy the other, which was executed by the said B. F. Smith with A. Rodrick security to Robt. L. Edwards for one hundred and thirty dollars, carrying interest from or about the 16th day of April 1847, and since that time assigned to the said W^m Munroe, on which bond suits have been instituted in the Circuit Court of said County, in the year 1851, and surplus if any then to after selling said interest and paying said debts pay over to said B.
