Witnesseth, that the said Mary Wick for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to her in hand paid by the said Joseph Davis at or before the enacting and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and delivery of granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain and sell to the said Joseph Davis his heirs and assigns all of her dower interest in a tract of land and its appurtenances, which the said Joseph Davis purchased of John Wattell of St. Carolina, known as a part of the latter tract. And the said Joseph Davis his heirs or assigns forever to have and to hold the said dower interest and all its appurtenances free from all claim or demand whatsoever from the said Mary Wick. In testimony whereof, the said Mary Wick has hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year above written.

Witnesseth that the said Robert Baughan and Sally J. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty three cents good and lawful money to them in hand paid by the said James Bardon at or before the enacting and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold unto him the said James Bardon his heirs and assigns forever, one third part of the undivided tract or parcel of land and premises, of which Manning Magrath of the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing by estimation two hundred nine & half acres, be the same more or less, and bounded by the lands of John C. Beale, John Hargrave, Polly Bingham, Matilda Bryant, and others. To have and to hold one third part of the above described tract or parcel of land and premises (being the said Baughans & wife's interest in the same) unto him the said James Bardon, his heirs and assigns forever, and to him for the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Bardon, his heirs and assigns forever.
