This Indenture, made this 17th day of January 1852, between Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife of the County of Sussex of the one part and Elizabeth Little of the County of Southampton of the other part; Witnesseth that the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Little, the receipt whereof the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth Little one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid, containing five hundred and eighty seven acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to-wit: on the North by the Land belonging to Kinchen Calks estate, South by the three Creeks, East by the said Elizabeth Little's land now owned Samuel Barkham's Land. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Elizabeth Little her heirs and assigns. And also all the right, title and interest whatsoever of them the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife, in and to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises to the proper use and behoof of her the said Elizabeth Little her heirs and assigns forever. And the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife for themselves and their heirs against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons, will warrant and by these presents forever defend. In witness whereof the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written.
