bargained, sold, alined, enfeoffed and confirmed unto these presents
as and each of them doth grant, bargain, sell, aline, enfeoff and confirm
unto him the said William C. Myrick his heirs and assigns forever.
One certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate, lying
and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish
of Saint Luke, containing by Survey one hundred and thirty seven &
half acres, be the same more or less it being a part of the
tract of land which formerly belonged to Dickson Furgason deceased
and which was sold by the heirs of Dickson Furgason to William T. Britt
and by the said Britt to William C. Myrick and for the boundaries
of said land see said deed from Britt to Myrick together with all
the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have
and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises
with all and singular its appurtenance unto him the said William C. Myrick,
his Heirs and assigns forever to and for the only
proper use and behoof of him the said William C. Myrick
his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry S. Furgason
and Ann Eliza his wife for themselves their heirs, Executors and
Administrators as and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to
and with the said William C. Myrick his Heirs, Executors
and Administrators as assigns, that they will by these presents warrant
and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid
tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel
thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every other
person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof, the said
