Olga Wells being desirous to secure the said R. G. Griffin, now
therefore this day made this 19th day of May 1849, between
Olga Wells of the first part, William R. Stephenson of the second
and R. G. Griffin of the third part: Witnesseth that the said
Olga Wells for and in consideration of one dollar to her in
hand paid by the said Wm R. Stephenson before the reading and
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, re-
leased and confirmed to the said William R. Stephenson, and
by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, re-
lease and confirm unto the said Wm R. Stephenson his
heirs and assigns all the right and title in the following
property, to wit: one mule, two feather beds, and furniture, or
least and wheels, seven head of hogs, one clock, two cows,
and the remainder of her household and kitchen furniture, and
farming utensils. To have and to hold the said property
to the only proper use of the said Wm R. Stephenson his heirs
or assigns, but for the benefit of aforesaid R. G. Griffin.
intend nevertheless that if the said Olga Wells should
pay or cause to be paid the aforesaid sum of fifty eight
dollars and 76 cents then and in that event this deed shall
be null and void. if not, then the said Wm R. Stephenson
at the request of the aforesaid R. G. Griffin, by giving
ten days previous notice as the law directs, shall proceed
to sell the before mentioned property or so much thereof
as may be necessary to pay the aforesaid debt and
