This Indenture, made and executed this 31st day of October A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Zachariah C. Holland and Ann S. his wife on the one part, and Eley Bradshaw of the other part, of the Upper Parish of Nansemond County and State of Virginia, the other of Southampton County and of the same State: Witnesseth that the said Zachariah C. Holland and Ann S. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Eley Bradshaw at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said Zachariah C. Holland and Ann S. his wife, hath granted, bargained and sold (and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Eley Bradshaw his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, about four miles from Jerusalem on the road called the Eagles Neck and Beginning at a old white oak in Alfred Hicks line, thence down the Branch a Southern course to Pottery Swamp, thence down the Swamp a Southeast course to the bridge, thence up the road a north east course to a Sassafras post, thence down thence a north west course to a old white oak, to the first Station containing one hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the appertinances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents, Issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular, other the promises hereinafore mentioned or intended to be bargained and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right members and appertinances unto the said Eley Bradshaw his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Zachariah C.
