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This deed made this 31st day of December A. D. 1857, between William D. Clarke of the first part, Cyre wife of the said William D. Clarke of the second part and Harrison D. Pope of the third part. Whereas the said William D. Clarke is possessed of an estate considerably more than sufficient for the payment of his debts and is anxious by deed to make provision for his said wife during his life, which shall not be subject to any casualties which may happen in his own fortunes. Now therefore in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to the said William D. Clarke in hand paid by the said Harrison D. Pope, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said William D. Clarke do grant, bargain, sell, assign & set over to the said Harrison D. Pope his Executors, administrators and assigns, certain lots with the improvements thereon and the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, situate in the town of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows; by the Courthouse Square, Nottoway river, the main Street, and Crossby's new Boxen lot, being the same lots which were conveyed to the said Clarke by deed from James B. Merghart and wife and others admitted to record the 9th day of April 1847. To have and to hold the premises above conveyed unto him the said Harrison D. Pope his Executors, administrators and assigns Upon trust & withethelf, and to and for such intents and purposes as aforesaid after mentioned that is to say, that the said Harrison D. Pope his executor administrators and assigns do and shall permit the said William D. Clarke during the joint lives of the said William D. & Cyre his wife, to have receive, take & enjoy for their joint benefit all the interest and profits of the said property hereby assigned and after the death of one of them the said Harrison D. Pope shall assign, set over and convey to the survivor, whether it be the said William D. or the said Cyre all the aforesaid property to be held by him or her and his or her assigns forever. And the said Harrison D. Pope shall at any time during the joint lives of the said William D. & Cyre with the approbation of the said William D. & Cyre signified by their uniting with him in a deed have power to sell and convey all the aforesaid property or any part thereof and must the monies arising from such sale in the purchase of other property or in such other manner as he with the approbation of the said Cyre may think most judicious, permitting the said William D. during the joint lives of himself and his
